



Irregular Plural Nouns Activity

Instructions

1. Complete the following irregular plural nouns with the student(s). Pick an example to model for them and emphasise that irregular plurals do not follow the standard plural -s rule (e.g., we cannot say 'mans' because irregular plurals are formed differently).
2. Go through each picture pair with the student(s). If their answer is incorrect when forming the irregular plural form, model the accurate response. As an extension activity, ask the student(s) to write in the missing plural under each picture.
3. For further practice, cut out the attached pictures and shuffle them to play a memory game. Lay the cards out on a flat surface or start with only a few pictures and gradually add more. The aim of the game is to find each singular-plural pair. With each turn, the student(s) must practice using the correct form, either singular or plural, depending on the card that they turn over.
