



Regular Plural Noun Activity

Instructions

1. Fill in the missing plural nouns below with the student(s). Pick an example to model for them and emphasise the plural /s/ sound on the end of plurals (e.g., “This is one dog. These are two *dogs*.”).
2. Go through each picture with the student. Model the correct answer if their answer is incorrect. As an extension activity, the student could be asked to write in the missing plural under each picture.
3. For further practice, cut out the attached pictures and shuffle them to play a memory game. Lay the cards out on a flat surface or table, and consider start with only a few pictures and gradually add more. The aim of the game is to find the singular-plural pair.
